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# *The Dominator Plan*

## **Introduction:**

There are many avenues to finding good horses to back in any given race. It does not matter whether it is in horse racing, trotting or dog races. What we are normally trying to do is to locate the main five or six runner. We are looking for the runners that will be accepted into ***The Dominator Plan***

To get an idea of what is out there you only have to look at the list below.

- Tipsters Polls (general newspaper polls)
- Tipsters Polls (compiled from your favourite tipsters)
- Weight rating services
- The immediate pre-race market
- Market movement lists

We will discuss each of these in a little more detail soon.

It doesn't matter in which country you live, there are literally scores of Polls, Rating services, pre-post bookmaker (or Tote) prices etc etc available.

The Dominator Plan is not only a great way to analyse a race and select the one, two or three horses that will most likely fight out the finish of a race, but will give you an edge over the bookmakers or the Totalisator.

What we are looking for is a way to selecting the value runners that have a top chances in any race. After we have done that we can identify the ones we want to support (and the ones we don't want to invest on).

There are many avenues to finding the main horses that we will analyse to see if they will fit into ***The Dominator Plan***. To get an idea of what is out there you only have to look at the list below.

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Later on we will focus mainly on two or three Australian sources...but you can get them in any country of the world.

### What is the Dominator Plan?

**The Dominator Plan** is a plan to identify the value runners (horses or greyhounds) in a race. We are looking for starters with starting prices at less than \$3.50 and more than \$8.50

There are a few strict rules to running The Dominator Plan to your advantage. We are looking to support the runners within **The Dominator Plan**. We are going to bet on only the runners starting at \$3.50 or greater and less than \$8.50. In some races there are anything from one to five or six runners fitting into the gap between \$3.50 and \$8.50.

What would you think of a race where there were five or six runners between \$3.50 and \$8.50? The answer would be that this particular race is a very, very open affair. This type of race is definitely one to walk away from.

On the other hand what about a race with one or none of the runners between \$3.50 and \$8.50. This type of race will have one or two horses below the starting price of \$3.50 and is either a one or two horse race. Again here is a good race to watch and save your money by not having a wager. Any race with two horses paying \$3.50 or less is good race to watch only. This equates to two horses less than 5/2. Under conditions like this it's a tough call to try and pick a winner outside the top two in the betting

One golden rule worth remembering **"IF YOU'RE NOT CONFIDENT WITH A WAGER ON A RACE... THEN IT'S BETTER TO WALK AWAY AND HAVE A CUP OF TEA"**..you don't have to bet on every race.

## Task No 1.

### Eliminate the 'Bad Races'

Every body in every country of the world might have a list of 'Bad Races' they can compile. The list below is our list for Australia. You might have more to add to it. It is so important to eliminate '**Bad Races**'. These races should be eliminated from your betting strategy when using past form as a selection criteria, such as rating, tipster polls etc. When using immediate pre-post market, you could decide to back on any race you fancy. When you are using a pre-post market you are 'following the money'.

These are our '**Bad Races**':

- 2 Year Old races. (Irrespective of the time of year)
- Maiden races
- Races with 6 or less runners
- Races with 13 or more runners.
- Races on Slow &/or Heavy tracks.

We are looking for races where the form is well known and there are between 6 and 12 runners in the race.

### Also at race time...stay clear of races where...

- Two or more horses are priced at \$3.50 or less
- There is only one eligible horse between \$3.50 and \$8.50
- There are four or more horses (in your selection group) between \$3.50 and \$8.50
- The favourite looks like starting at \$1.70 or less.

On an average Saturday there will be between 12 and 15 eligible races spread over Brisbane...Sydney...Melbourne...Adelaide.

We aim to increase our Bank by 20% and we usually do this by betting in 6 - 12 races.

Whether your currency is Euro, pound or dollar these prices are the same.

### Using a weight rating service

On the previous page is a copy of the Wizard Quick Form Guide\* (see note at end of document) for Rosehill on the 19<sup>th</sup> March 2005 that we can use to identify these five or six main chances in any given race.

Or Racing Post in the UK.

In race no 1 there was only one selection from the list provided after scratchings so by looking through the complete list we found no 3, 4 and 9. No 3 won and paid \$6.00

Using this attached PDF file for Rosehill (19.03.05) race No 2 we can see how to run the selection plan.

### Race No 2

1 Natural Blitz (scratched)

**3 Jeremaid \$8.40**

**4 Daniel's The Man \$4.70**

6 Havana Wind \$2.90 (Favourite)

**8 Hassle \$5.70**

9 Square One \$10.60

The above TAB dividends are recorded a minute or two before start time.

The only horses in Race No 2 between \$3.50 and \$8.50 are Nos 3, 4 and 8

We backed 3 horses in this race..... Nos 3, 4 and 8

### Result:

**1st No 3 Jeremaid \$8.40 Win tote (UniTab Dividend)**

2nd No 6 Havana Wind

3rd No 8 Hassle

## Newspaper Tipsters Polls

Another easy way to identify the top five or six main chances in a race is to use newspaper **tipsters' polls**.

As an example we can take a look at the poll from The Brisbane Courier Mail for Saturday 7th May 2005 Flemington Race No 4.

The first three races on the program were eliminated.

Race No 1 was a 'Bad race' of 1200 metres –Flemington

Race No 2 was a 'Bad Race' – a 2 year old race.

Race No 3 was a 'Bad Race' 13 runners...field size too big

### **Race No 4 Okay. 9 starters, Open handicap over 1610 meters**

Brisbane Courier Mail Tipsters Poll:

No 2 Mr. Murphy.....	10 points	\$3.90
No 3 Blessum.....	8 points	\$3.90
<b>No 6 Botero.....</b>	<b>4 points</b>	<b>\$5.20</b>
<del>No 10 Caveat Emptor.....</del>	<del>4 points (scratched)</del>	
No 1 Chattanooga.....	2 points	\$11.50

#### Result:

**1st No 6 Botero \$5.20 Win tote (UniTab Dividend)**

2nd No 2 Mr Murphy

3rd No 7 I Do Blue

Markets prior to race time.

At the end of the day, the real chances in any race are identified by the weight of money wagered on all runners. The most favoured runners attract the most money with the bookies Totalisator or Betting exchange...the least favoured attract the least. The more money invested the lower the price.

Why not take the top five horses in the betting just before barrier race. Nowadays the Sky channel telecast displays the race favourites in a convenient list. You might like to bet on every race available.

You might see something like this:

(Flemington Race 6 7<sup>th</sup> May 2005)

No 14 Activation \$2.20  
No 3 Tall Timbers \$7.10  
No 2 Recapitalize \$7.60  
No 15 Picket Fence \$9.90

Selections would be Nos 2 and 3.

Result:

1<sup>st</sup> No 2 Recapitalize \$7.60  
2<sup>nd</sup> No 14 Activation  
3<sup>rd</sup> No 3 Tall Timbers

How to bet on two or three horse in a race...

There has been one very sound method of betting on a number of horses in a race and come out a winner if one is successful. This has been the "DUTCH BOOK" method of wagering.

I was a constantly using this method until I developed the **Multi-Bets Program**.

The **Multi-Bets Program** is literally light years ahead of any Dutch Book method. **The Multi-Bets Program** is based on ideas developed by a professional punter and used for the past decade with great results.

The Dominator Plan...The Lite Version



If you would like to have lots and lots of bets using **The Dominator Plan** in conjunction with the Multi-Bets Excel Spreadsheet then may we suggest that you give some thought to the following:

1. Bet in all race types, but **not in races** run on tracks that are **Slow or Heavy**.
2. **Stay clear of the straight races** at courses like Flemington (Vic) or Victoria Park (S.Aust).
3. Invest in races with between **6 and 12 starters only**.
4. **Avoid** all races **where the favourite is odds-on** (Paying less then \$2.00 Win)
5. **Avoid** all races **where there are two runners priced at \$3.50 or less Win**.
6. Looking down the TAB list of runners **select the first three** in saddlecloth order showing a return of **between \$3.50 and \$8.50**.
7. **Bet on the eligible runners**...be it one, two or three horses.
8. **Use the Multi-Bets Software**

#### Notes:

1. The Wizard Newspaper produces a daily internet based Quick Form through their web page at <http://www.everyrace.com>. The cost is \$2.20 per race meeting.
2. In Australia there are many sites providing race ratings and other forms of race selections. One of the best websites is <http://www.racingpages.com.au/>. This site has links to numerous sites providing racing information
3. In Australia the Victorian TAB (SuperTab) and the Queensland TAB (UniTab) provide, free of charge, a rating list for all runners in every race.
4. No matter how you arrive at your main selections in a race you will be streets ahead when you apply the Multi-Bets software to your betting. You can obtain Multi-Bets by clicking on the link below:
